

District 17 Continues Improvement & Upgrades

Projects scheduled include additional waterline replacements and upgrades in the Hudson Bend area, Apache Shores and River Ridge areas. Some small loop connections are planned for RM 620. All new waterlines will have fire hydrants installed approximately every 500 feet. Funding for the line replacement projects comes from the District Operation and Maintenance tax. Funding for Apache Shores and River Ridge projects is from their respective Out-of-District fee. Funding for new infrastructure such as water tanks and plumbing stations comes from one-time Impact Fees collected from new customers who are connecting their property to the WCID 17 system for the first time. Mountain View Elevated Water Tank	1 million gallon elevated composite tank: Site work started
Cloudy Ridge Control Valve Upgrades	Upgrade of valves & controls at Cloudy Ridge & RM 620: Complete and in-service – Revegetation to be done
Low Water Crossing, Lake Austin	Replace and upgrade 6" waterline with a 12" waterline plus two valves: Complete
Steiner Ranch Effluent Irrigation Improvements	Irrigation Repairs and Improvements in Steiner Ranch: Complete
River Ridge Waterline Projects	Terjo Lane – 2,450 feet of 8" waterline from Quinlan Park to River Bend: Waiting for County approvals
City of Austin Emergency Interconnect	16" waterline along RM 620 from Comanche Trail to Bullick Hollow for provision of emergency water: Permit being finalized
