

## District 17 Plans for Continuous Improvement & Upgrades FY 2011-2012

The District has an extensive project schedule planned for 2011-2012. Additional waterline replacements and upgrades will be done in the Hudson Bend area, Apache Shores and River Ridge area. Some small loop connections are planned for RM 620, and additional line upgrades will be done in conjunction with the Lakeway Regional Medical Center Project. All new waterlines will have fire hydrants installed approximately every 500 feet. Funding for the line replacement projects comes from the District Operation and Maintenance tax. Funding for new infrastructure such as water tanks and pumping stations comes from one-time impact fees collected from new customers who are connecting their property to the District system for the first time. Funding for Apache Shores and River Ridge projects is collected through Out of District fees.

<b>RM 620 Waterline Improvements</b>	Contract Awarded – 380 LF 8” waterline – RM 620 between Storm & Stroup
<b>Lakeway Interconnect</b>	Under construction, completion Fall 2010 – Upgrading to 16” waterline
<b>Delsie Drive &amp; Joseph Drive</b>	Contract Awarded – Connect waterline in back of Chase Bank across from Lakeway Blvd.
<b>Flintrock Area</b>	In Permitting – Flintrock Trace - Relocate 12” waterline Add Parallel 16” waterline
<b>Mountain View Elevated Water Tank</b>	In Permitting – 1 million gallon elevated composite tank
<b>Cloudy Ridge Control Valve Upgrades</b>	In Permitting – Upgrade of valves & controls at Cloudy Ridge & RM 620
<b>Low Water Crossing, Lake Austin</b>	Contract Awarded – Replace and upgrade 6” waterline with a 12” waterline plus two valves
<b>Steiner Ranch Effluent Irrigation Improvements</b>	Contract Awarded
<b>River Ridge Waterline Projects</b>	Contract Awarded – Terjo Lane – 2,450 feet of 8” waterline from Quinlan Park to River Bend
<b>City of Austin Emergency Interconnect</b>	In Permitting – 16” waterline along RM 620 from Comanche Trail to Bullick Hollow for provision of emergency water
