

Hazardous Waste Collection

Each year, WCID17 participates in a special event for hazardous waste disposal. This collection is for items that are not allowed to be disposed of in the weekly garbage receptacles provided to our customers by our Solid Waste provider. Watch WCID17.org and your *Waterline* newsletter for announcement of date, time and place of collection to be held annually.

Allowable Items Include:

- Drain cleaners
- Degreasers
- Solvents
- Polishes
- Pool chemicals
- Batteries (auto & household)
- Paint and strippers
- Preservatives
- Pesticide sprays and dusts
- Weed killers
- Rat poison
- Antifreeze
- Brake fluid
- Transmission fluid
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Computers

You **CANNOT** bring:

- Medical waste
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Tires
- Containers larger than 5 gal
- Radioactive materials
- Explosive materials
- Industrial waste



Safety Tips: Transport chemicals in the trunk of your car. Keep products in their original containers if possible. Do not combine chemicals.
