

Household Collection Guidelines

Solid Waste Collection Service, one time per week, will be on **your same designated day** each week. A separate truck from the Recycle Collection truck will pick up solid waste materials.

- One (1) 96-Gallon Cart Provided by IESI.
- Place cart and up to (3) bags or bundles at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.
- Large or bulky items will be collected at curbside.
- Special house-side collection service can be provided for residents that are physically challenged or have a disability requiring assistance, upon request and approval by WCID17's General Manager.
- Additional carts and bins are available for residents requiring more than one, for an additional charge.

Your Recycle Collection Service day will also be on **the same day** and your recycle bin should be out at the curb by 7:00 a.m. A separate truck from the Solid Waste Collection truck will pick up recycle materials. This truck will look like a solid waste collection truck, but it is for single stream recycle and will have "Recycle" on it.

- Curbside recycling collection one (1) time per week.
- One (1) 18-gallon recycling bin provided by IESI.
- Rinse all food wastes from recyclables.
- Place all recyclables in the bin. No sorting is required but keep your newspapers separate and dry.
- Place recycle bin five (5) feet away from your trash cart.
- Additional bins are available for residents requiring more than one for an additional charge.
