



**NEW DEFINITION OF STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT**  
WCID No. 17 will begin enforcement of once-per-week watering February 1, 2024



**Stage 1 - Baseline Water Conservation**  
>900,000 Acre-Feet Combined Storage  
- Twice per Week Watering

**Stage 2 - Moderate Water Shortage**  
900,000 - 750,000 Acre-Feet  
- Once per Week Watering

**Stage 3 - Severe Water Shortage**  
750,000 - 600,000 Acre-Feet  
- No Watering Allowed

**Stage 4 - Critical Water Conditions**  
600,000 Acre-Feet  
- No Watering Allowed

With the Acre-Feet of combined storage at Lake Buchanan and Lake Travis between 750,000 and 900,000, we are currently in Stage 2 which means a maximum of once per week watering. **Your designated day is based on the last digit of your address:**

- **Monday: 0, 1 (Residential)**
- **Tuesday: 4, 5, 6 (Residential)**
- **Wednesday: 7, 8, 9 (Residential)**
- **Thursday: 2, 3 (Residential)**
- **Friday: Commercial/HOAs**
- **Saturday: No automated systems are allowed**
- **Sunday: No automated systems are allowed**

**Watering should occur a max of ONE DAY PER WEEK on your designated day.**  
Approved hours are between 12 a.m.-10 a.m. and 7 p.m.-12 a.m. on your authorized day.

Above-ground (hose-end) sprinklers are allowed on designated day between hours of 12 a.m.- 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. - 12 a.m. Hand-held hose or Bucket watering is allowed any day but NOT between 10 a.m. – 7 p.m.
